

Day Habilitation Services

LDA's Day Habilitation Services support individuals' participation in structured activities during the day. Activities may be designed for either individual or group participation. LDA's Day Habilitation Services options include:

- **Nicholas C. Shakeshaft Learning Center** offers easy-to-use computers and friendly instructors ready to help participants improve reading, writing and computer skills...and have fun at the same time!
- **Atelier of Art** is a working art studio and gallery. The Atelier artists participate in individual or small group instruction in a variety of arts and crafts. They also enjoy excursions to community cultural activities and events.
- **Community Day Habilitation** supports participants in accessing community resources/activities either in a group setting or individually. Activities are tailored to the participant's interests and goals.

Who Would Benefit From Day Habilitation Services

People with developmental disabilities who are unemployed often benefit from participating in structured activities during the day. Individuals must be eligible for OMRDD services and either receive Medicaid or meet the criteria for "Urgent Need" status.
