LDA's Residential Services provide personalized services to enhance the lives of individuals living with developmental disabilities. Residential Services staff recognize individuals' strengths and have compassion for their challenges.

Residential Services are provided in a variety of individualized settings, offering many options and creative solutions, including:

**Supervised IRA (Individual Residential Alternative)** offers a wide variety of IRAs providing staff supervision 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

**Supported IRA** offers support services within apartment style living. Individuals receive services based on their needs. Apartments are one or two bedrooms.

**Shared Living** offers a family style approach in which individuals live in private homes within the community.

**Community Residential Habilitation** offers support services to be provided in the individual's own home as desired by the individual.
